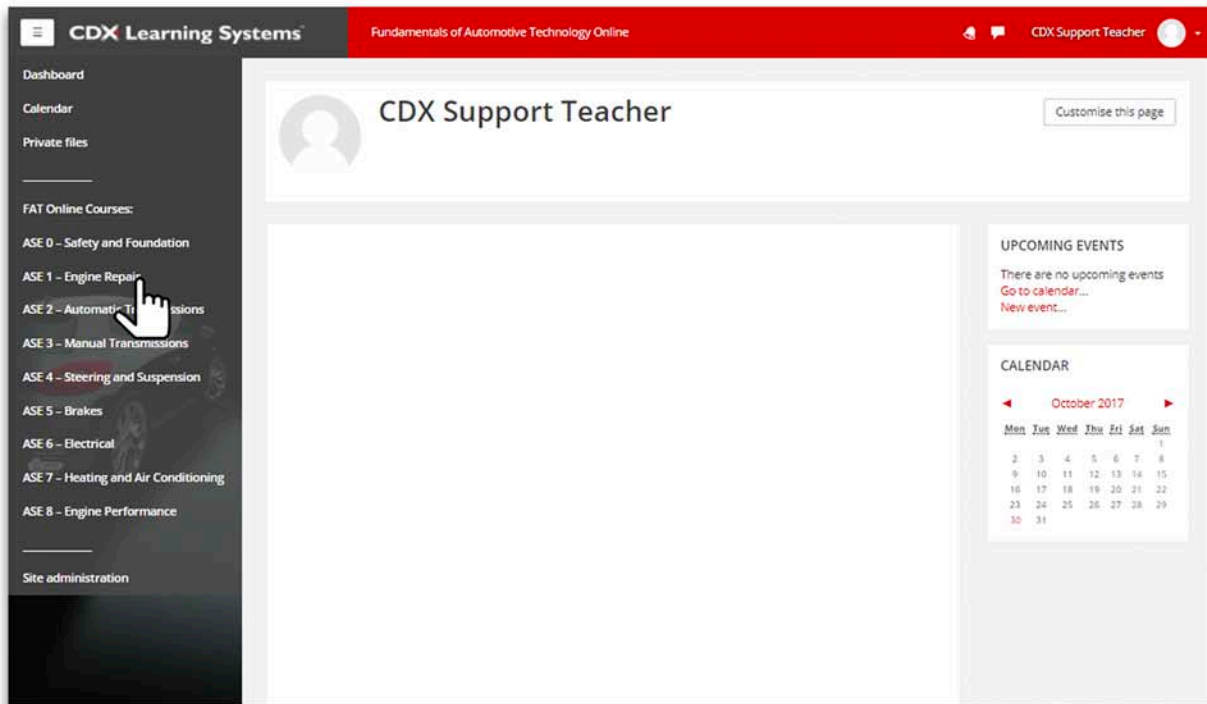

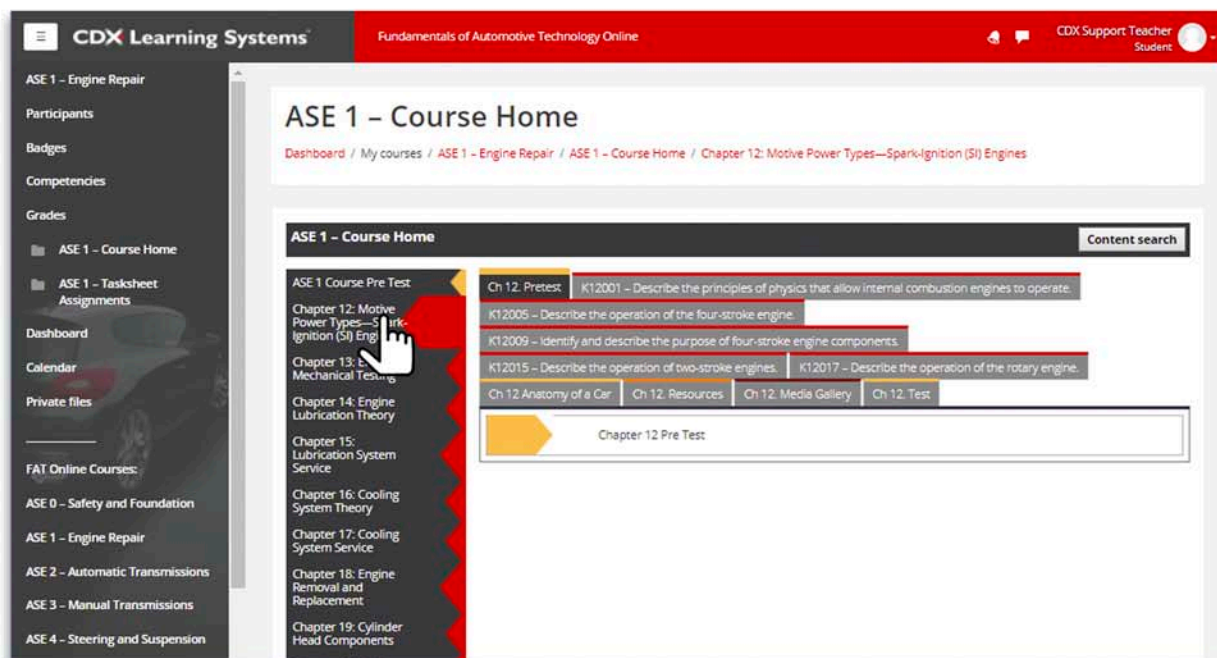

Click on the course that contains the chapter containing the Anatomy of a Car Animations from the navigation on the left.

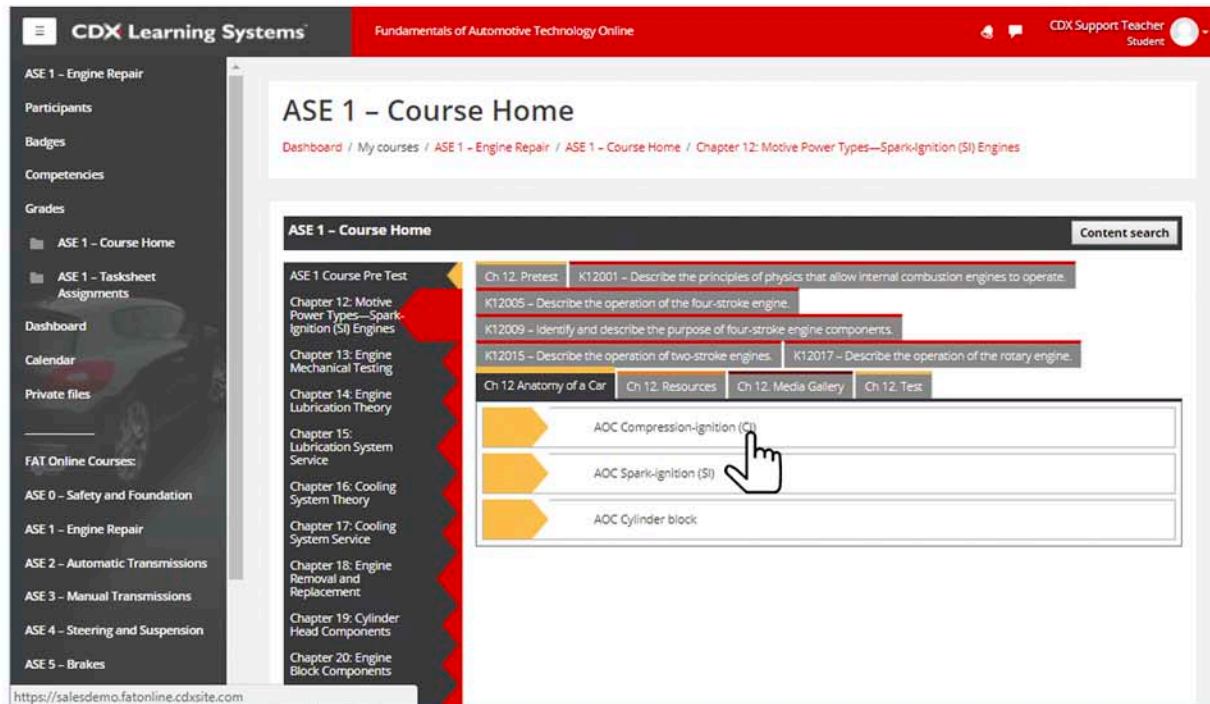

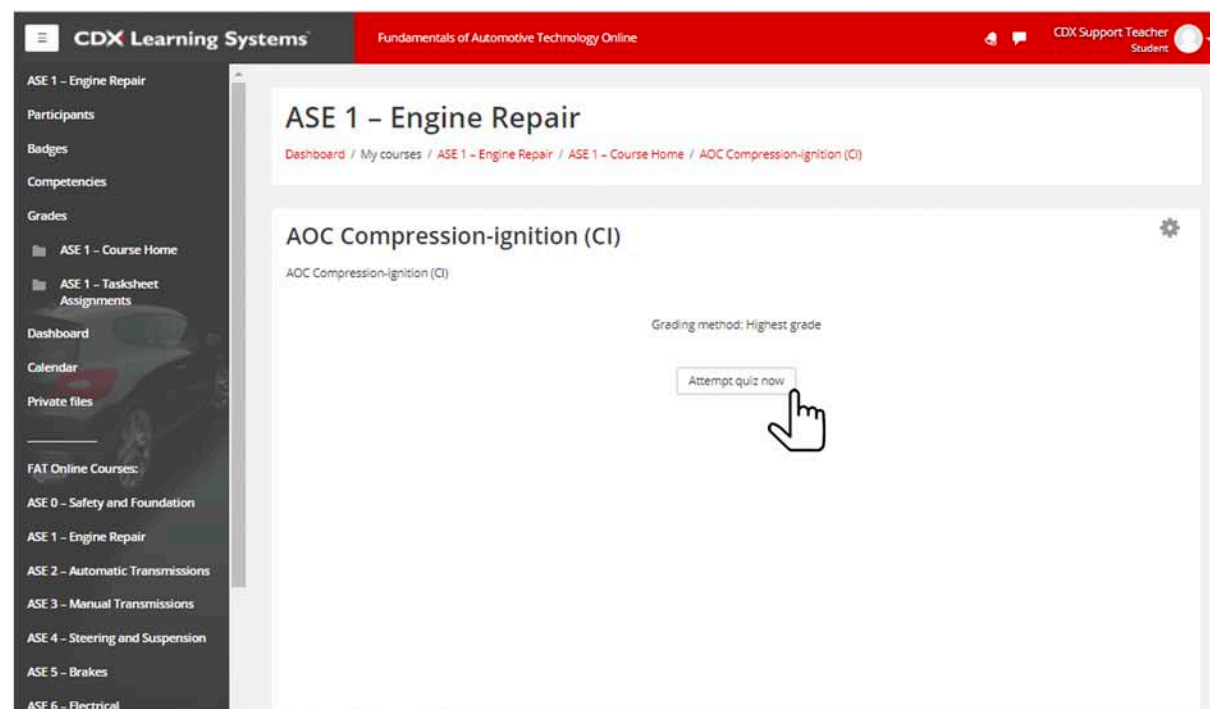


Any chapter that contains Anatomy of a Car Animations will have a section after the Knowledge Areas labeled “Anatomy of a Car”.
